By now, you are well aware of all SCPS instruction moving to an online Distance Learning platform. Midway Elementary will be using Google Classroom. All of our teachers and instructional support staff have been hard at work all week creating their classrooms and lessons so that we can continue to provide educational services for each of your children.

On Monday, March 30, your child will be able to access their Portal and see their classroom. Please be sure that they do so and that they take part in all learning activities for all of their teachers. **Of utmost importance, the “compulsory education” law is still in effect, which means that ALL children must continue to attend school, in this case Distance Learning.** All students will receive grades and a 4<sup>th</sup> quarter report card for their core subject areas of ELA/Reading, Math, and Science. Although students will receive grades, please note that grading will be very different depending on the assignment and/or activity. Classroom teachers will also reach out to students and families to discuss ongoing progress and to support students. Teachers will coordinate with parents to arrange the mode of communication and the schedule.

Students will also have an opportunity to continue to partake in Arts classes (Band, Orchestra, Musical Theater, Art, Dance, PE). All students receiving services for ESE, ESOL, 504 will also continue to receive services and support from their assigned teachers.
